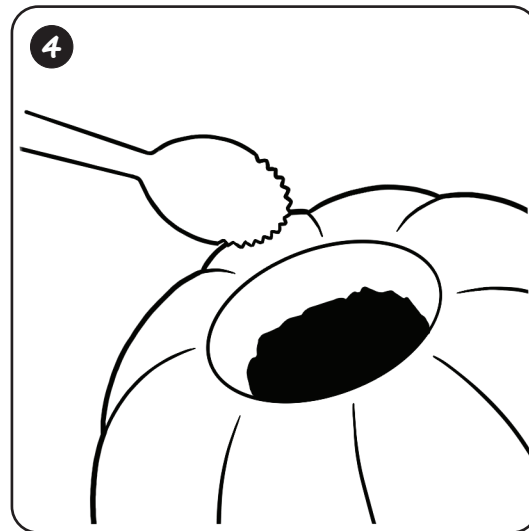
These patterns can be used for more than carving pumpkins. Cut them out to use as stencils for painting, or just use them for decoration!



When attaching your pattern to the pumpkin, make sure to cut along the dotted lines, and overlap the corners so the paper conforms to the pumpkin.



To transfer the pattern, affix it to your pumpkin securely, and use a thumb tack (or similar object) to poke holes along the pattern borders. After all lines are marked, remove the pattern, and simply carve along the lines!



If your pumpkin is particularly thick-walled, you can use a spoon to hollow out the inside (serrated spoons are best.) A wall thickness of 3/4" - 1" (~20 mm - 25 mm) is ideal, and will make carving easier, as well as increase light transmission.
